A Sporting Chance is a 15 year old organization that is committed to developing and providing amateur athletic training, competition and recreational programs for **any person with any disability, youth who are disadvantaged, "At Risk" Teenagers, abused & neglected children and Senior Citizens.** We have also added the **"Caring Communities Kids" to our program after they suffered budget cuts.** A Sporting Chance is a local program with no affiliation with any State or National organization.

As is the case with all Not-For-Profit Organizations raising funds is an integral part of A Sporting Chance. The 2007 Fiscal Year Budget will be approximately **\$250,000** and most of the money will be raised doing fund-raising projects and relying on our business friends for support.
